Per Annum

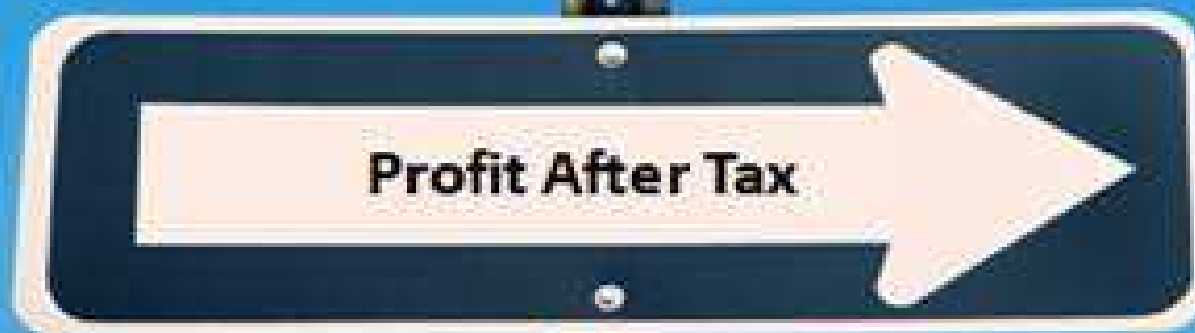
It is used to express the financial context for yearly sales, expenses, earnings etc.
